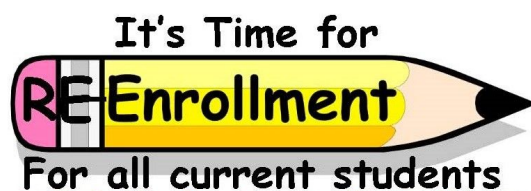
### Principal's Pen

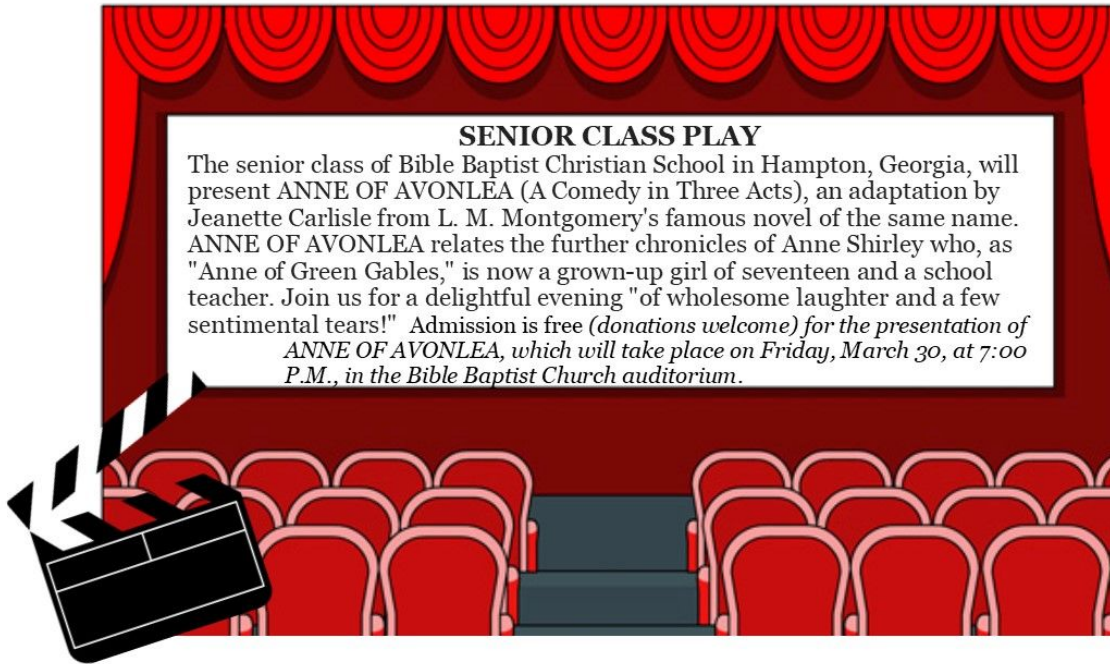
