7 -12 pickup after school

Reminder: If you arrive early to pick up 7th - 12th grade students in the afternoon, you may back into a spot right alongside of the church, which also allows you to leave easily without waiting in line and keeps those students from having to cross any traffic. In addition, if you are one of the cars in front of the car line, and your child is slow in arriving, pull ahead into one of the spots on the side of the church so that cars behind you may leave.

Please do not park in front of the gym, as we want to leave those spots open for the safety of the students. We do not want students to cross traffic which also impedes traffic flow.
