Frosty Shop ~ Sponsored by the Senior Class

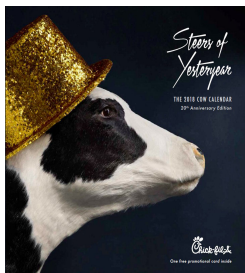
