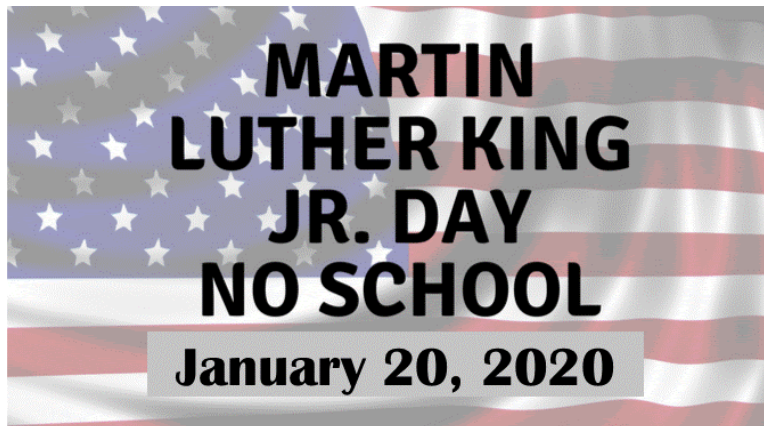
We anticipate this week to be a great week of academic progress. Thanks for your support.

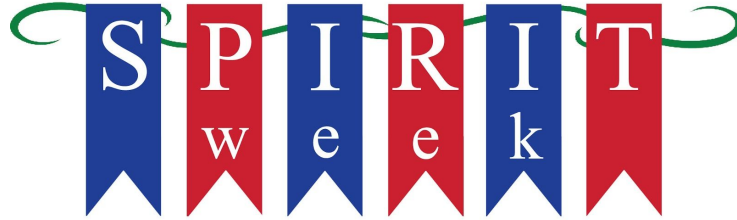
Basketball and cheerleading team pictures will be taken on January 21. If you would like individual pictures please see Mrs. Carter.
